Parking Request/Notice: As we prepare to welcome our friends from St Barnabas', we ask that you consider parking on Sundays in the Hunter St circle, the ScotiaBank lot on the south side of Hunter St, or behind the courthouse (for a small fee) if you are able to walk up the hill or for longer distances.
