First Sunday in Lent: February 21

When God waited patiently in the days of Noah, during the building of the ark.

Second Sunday in Lent: February 28

The poor shall eat and be satisfied, and those who seek the Lord shall praise him.

—Psalm 22:25

- *Bake cookies or other treats to drop off at One Roof Community Centre to sweeten the midday meal*

Third Sunday in Lent: March 7

Their sound has gone out into all lands; and their message to the ends of the world.

—Psalm 19:4

- *Think of a friend to whom you have not spoken in a while and give them a call to say hello and catch up*

Fourth Sunday in Lent: March 14

Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.

—Psalm 107:19

- *Hand and foot warmers*
- *Cotton or wool socks*
- *Tim Horton or McDonald's gift cards*

Fifth Sunday in Lent: March 21

Jesus offered up prayers and supplications... and he was heard.

—Hebrews 5:7

- *This week, commit yourself to be more intentional in prayer: take time to pray for someone in need*

Palm Sunday: March 28

Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord.
