Adam and Anna and their children, Luke, Caleb, and Kara, live in The Netherlands and serve at Tyndale Theological Seminary. The school focuses on training up the global church to fulfill the Great Commission, bringing together students from across Africa, Europe, and Asia to prepare them for ministry.

Happy New Year!

I [Adam] taught two classes last term: Biblical Theology and Colossians. The Biblical Theology course is the biggest class I have had at Tyndale so far with twenty-three students. Our first year class of twenty students is the largest we have had at Tyndale for at least ten years. They are a group that is eager to learn, ask questions, and engage in discussion. Collectively, they are one of the most encouraging groups I have had — sharing about what they are learning, how much they are enjoying their time at Tyndale, and quick to laugh. We had a group of them over for dessert a few weeks ago and had a great time getting to know them better. Many are from Africa, one is from Nepal, a few are from the Netherlands, both Dutch nationals and from immigrant communities here, so it is a beautifully diverse group.

The course on Colossians had second-year students. It also is a larger class, so I have been busier with grading this term — payback for giving all those assignments in the first place!

I continue to mentor a group of four students, and this has been my favorite term of mentoring so far. We are reading the book How to Know a Person by David Brooks which has led to a lot of good conversations about how we engage with others and how we can ask intentional questions to get to know them. In that group, one student is getting married in May, another is the Tyndale student body president, another is interning at our church, and the other one serves as the worship leader for our chapels.

Anna started her project management role at Tyndale this past Fall and has found more than enough work to keep her busy and is seeing good fruit from her efforts. In addition to working in the office, she continues to minister through her presence, hospitality, and service to students through things like hosting them in our home, baking birthday cakes, and attending chapel in order to build relationships through regular contact.

Our church plant here in Badhoevedorp has continued to be a blessing. Recently we had a Dutch family from the community visit after hearing about the church from a Tyndale student. They shared that they have been praying for a faithful church in our village for ten years and were encouraged to see that God had brought it to life. It was a great reminder that God is always at work ahead of us and is the One who brings such things about. What a joy to take part!

Kara started attending preschool at the same school as Luke and Caleb. Originally, it was four full days, but that was wearing her out more than we thought was good, so she has switched to two full days and two half days. Her teacher tells us that her Dutch is coming along, which is encouraging, but she has had a hard time with the transition. Pray for grace for her and wisdom as we parent her through this big time.

Caleb has started playing soccer this season and is loving it. He enjoys the new challenge and has learned a lot. At school, he is learning about knights and the medieval period, so he occupies himself with making helmets, swords/shields, and banners out of cardboard packaging.


We welcome your prayers:

- For Luke & Caleb, please pray for good friendships, settledness and confidence in their school studies and growth in their relationships with God.




Points for Prayer:
