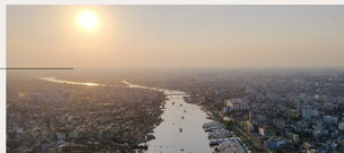

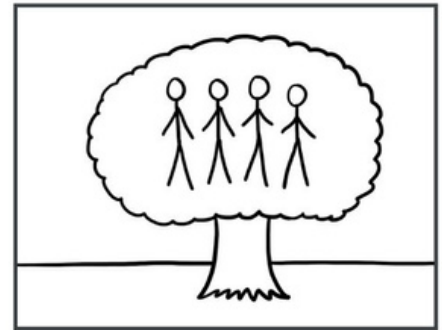

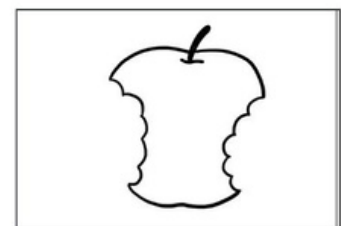


Bible StoryBoards help us to learn and share God's life-giving story with others.
