StoryBoard 1: Beginnings

The Big Idea: God creates a perfect world to share with mankind.

In the beginning God created the heavens and earth. It was the beginning of everything we know and everything we are. That story is told in the first two chapters of Genesis, the book aptly named for its focus on the beginning of the world.

Though our brains can't understand how it happened, God took a barren planet and turned it into the world that we now know. Continents, oceans, jungles, mountains & valleys, fruit trees, wildflowers... Birds, wolves, elephants, dolphins... and man, beginning with Adam & Eve. He created it all for one purpose - so people could walk with Him, and with each other, in a loving relationship.

How is it possible that a whole lot of something was created out of nothing? Did it all happen in six literal days? Or was it actually six eras of time? And where did God come from anyway? So many questions.

But we can be sure of this: the Bible from beginning to end goes to great lengths to answer the *why* question. *Why* did God make the heavens and the earth? The sun and the moon? Trees and animals? The *why* is what Bible StoryBoards is all about. It's the bottom line of the story God tells from the first to the last page of the Bible. And the answer is simple: God created the world and people because He wants to have a genuine loving relationship with us, and He wants us to have a genuine loving relationship with each other, forever.

God and a relationship with Him were at the center of everything for the first two humans. It was only natural for them to walk and talk with Him. To honor Him. In the Garden of Eden, life was like God intended it to be. Perfect and complete. No pain. No fear. No sickness. God and man living life together in perfect harmony. Wouldn't it be great if life could be like that again?

You'd think mankind would jump at the opportunity to live in vital communion with the God of the universe. Well... think again. And so the story continues...


