In my book on Resilience, I talk about Encore Ministry. Now I am entering that season. The concert of ministry, a kingdom stage of collaboration between God, ourselves, all of our supporters and ministry participants—a beautiful symphony—has reached its climatic finale. So, what's next?

- More time with Eriko, our children and grandkids. Our seventh grandchild, Lisa Ann, was born to our daughter Jasmine in September.
- Resilience coaching. I have been asked to assist the Japan side of our mission, Asian Access Japan, with coaching leaders. I will be part of a training event in January. I want to do some writing related to coaching questions, and a devotional guide about finding renewal amidst adversity.
- Be a personal water station. I will continue Three Stream Ministries through coaching, counseling and mentoring leaders. It will be a focused, reproducible model. I will come alongside leaders for refreshment and encouragement.
- Slow and quickly. You might ask, what is your pace? I think back to the words of my father-in-law. When we got married, he told me to go slow quickly. Over the years I have interpreted his words to mean to live with intention, value people and know your surroundings. For me, this means my encore will proceed slowly, one step, one person and one moment at a time. As I look at Jesus' life, I can see how he lived that way during his short time on this earth.
- Hobbies. I want to continue to run and bike. I may add some others later.
- Prayer walks. I will continue to do prayer walks in church planting communities and our own neighborhood of Katsura.

It has been a marathon, a bike race, and a relay event. Ministry in Japan is a long, joyful, God-paced journey not of speed or efficiency but of brokenness, grace, transformation, and intimacy with the one who sees. Jesus ran the most important race to the cross and heaven. The dynamic gospel has changed a multitude of lives. Now we are handing off the ministry baton to others.

In recent months, two men with whom I studied the Bible for years, and who now meet with one of my mentees, have received Christ as their Saviour and have been baptized. Pray for Mr. T. and Naoki. Please also pray for 79-year old Harumi, who has yet to accept Christ.

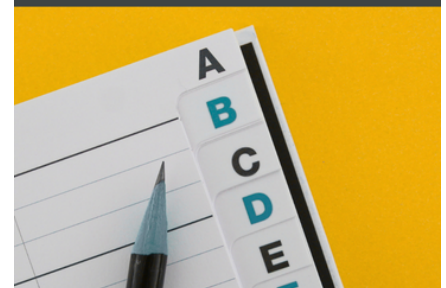
Points for Prayer:
