Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

I have lived in Santa Rosa since I was six. The best thing about here is that we live in close proximity to family.

What was your first job, and what's a lesson from it that's stuck with you?

I was a janitor at my dad's work, a health insurance agency owned by John Hansen. I later changed roles to data enterer. My time working there has increased my ability to pay attention to what I am supposed to be doing.

Tell us about your family.

My brothers and I will often play multiplayer games like Hearthstone and Minecraft. Our sisters sometimes join in with other games like Mario Kart.

What led you to decide to follow Christ?

When I was four, my mother read to me the story of the Tower of Babel in the Jesus Storybook Bible. The storybook said they were trying to get to God by building a tall tower, and Mom commented that there was only one way to God, referring to Jesus. I then said that I wanted to take this route, to bring about and secure my salvation.

What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?

One thing I have recently learned is that thankfulness can significantly brighten your view on today. Focusing on the great quantity of sin in the world can give you a cynical point of view, but when you are thankful for what we have and what Jesus has done through his Spirit, it can brighten your perspective. I think it is valuable to thank God for what the world often takes for granted.

How did you come to be at Redemption Hill?

Before the merge, we went to Calvary Community, partially because this is where our grandparents went. We have been going to this church since we moved to Santa Rosa.

What advice would you give to someone who's new to Redemption Hill?

Read the Bible. It has 50 stars (or, at least, 50 times the word "stars" is used in the ESV).





- Ministry Partners: Thanks and praise for those doing Kingdom work in this area, especially Redwood Gospel Mission, Young Life, and Intervarsity.


