

The Bible is a love story. It tells of God's love for us and His relentless pursuit of a relationship with us. Yet as God has relentlessly pursued us, we have played hard to get. We've turned away. We've used Him for our benefit and then gone our own way. Over and over again.

Bible StoryBoards walk us through the progress of that story through fifteen key periods of history that are described in the Bible. Each week, one of these pictures will be printed in the church bulletin for you to review, and once a month we'll examine one of the StoryBoards in greater depth.

Our hope is that Bible StoryBoards will help you tap into the life-changing potential that is found in God's Word, that you will be forever changed by what you learn, and that you will then share this amazing story with others.

StoryBoard 2: Sin

The Big Idea: Man Messes Up and Paradise is Lost

The next time you think about doing something God's said not to do, you may want to bring to mind the stories of Adam & Eve, Noah, and the Tower of Babel. Remembering what happened in those historical events might keep you from making a really bad decision that could have serious consequences.

Adam & Eve were placed in a perfect world so that together they could enjoy a relationship with God. There was only one thing God told them not to do. He told them not to eat from one particular fruit tree that was in the Garden of Eden. And what did Adam & Eve do? They ate that fruit. And because of that choice, sin entered the world for the first time. The consequences were devastating in their relationship with God, and with each other, and for the world itself. So much was lost because of that one bad decision. Among other things, they lost intimacy with God, a perfect home, marital harmony, painless childbirth, perfect children, sweat-less work, perfect health, and life without death. They went from having it all to struggling to have anything at all, because they chose to put their will above God's.

Yet God continued to provide for them and care for them.

As the population of the world grew, sin also spread among mankind. Things eventually got so bad that God sent a flood to wipe out all those who refused to turn from their wickedness and turn back to God. Yet God provided a way of escape through **Noah** and his family.

After the flood, the world began repopulating through Noah's descendents. For a time mankind walked with God again, but eventually they chose to turn from God and to their own sinful ways once again. But this time, instead of sending another flood and starting over again, God miraculously caused the people to begin speaking in different languages at the **Tower of Babel**. As the people

In spite of God's efforts to encourage mankind to walk with Him in love, from the very beginning humans have continued to choose to do what was right in their own eyes instead of following God's ways. And we do the same thing today. Sin is now a part of our very nature.

Yet God's relentless pursuit of a loving relationship with people like us is evident from the moment sin came into the world. Immediately following Adam and Eve's sin, God promised to send someone who would defeat Satan and his work in the world (Gen. 3:15). Then God graciously provided clothing for His disobedient children and removed them from the Garden of Eden so they wouldn't be able to continue eating from the tree of life, which would have caused them to live forever in their sin, separated from God. Why bother? Because God longed to be in a loving relationship with man.

More than a thousand years after these events, God spoke again of His longing for a relationship with people like us. He said, "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with loving-kindness." (Jer. 31.:3) That is certainly evident from His interaction with Adam & Eve, Noah, and the people of Babel.
