Women's Retreat

Each month, we pray for another Northern Californian church that's seeking to proclaim the gospel of Christ. This month, Matty Blevin, English Pastor of the Japanese Christian Church of Walnut Creek, shares a little about his flock and how we can be in prayer for them.

The Japanese Christian Church of Walnut Creek (JCCWC) was planted in 1977 and today is a small ethnic church that aspires to reach the Japanese people, both locally and in Japan. In addition, we have recently begun to embrace the call to reach our neighbors and those who are in need.

JCCWC is part of a conference of churches called the OMS Holiness Conference, with churches in Nor Cal, So Cal and Hawaii. The purpose of the conference is to come alongside the local churches as they aspire to fulfill their mission in reaching the Japanese people group.

As Japan is one of the least Christian countries in the world (recent figures show less than 1%), our mission is crucial. In addition, the Japanese people group is shrinking in both Japan (due to progressively more deaths than births) and in

America (less are immigrating to America from Japan). As one sorrowful Japanese woman told me, "Matty Sensei, we are an endangered species." This makes both our commitment to our calling and our ability to pivot in these changing times imperative.

One of the ways God is growing us is by making our local churches and pastors more ethnically diverse. This is difficult for many in the Japanese culture as change and diversity challenge some key Japanese cultural traits that have enabled Japan to exist as a civilization for over a thousand years. Pray for us as we seek to bring the Kingdom of God and its culture, through Christ, to the Japanese people group and our neighbors, on earth as it is in heaven.

Points for Prayer

- For our people, that they would be able to embrace both the Japanese people group and their American neighbors, whoever that may be.
- For our church, we would be able to navigate the change in missions to the Japanese people group based on their shrinking numbers both in Japan and in America.
- For our conference (kind of like our denomination) that we would be able to pivot based on the changing generations.
- For Pastor Matty Blevins. That he may delight himself in the Lord and that this delight would express itself in holiness and love.




