Easter Celebration

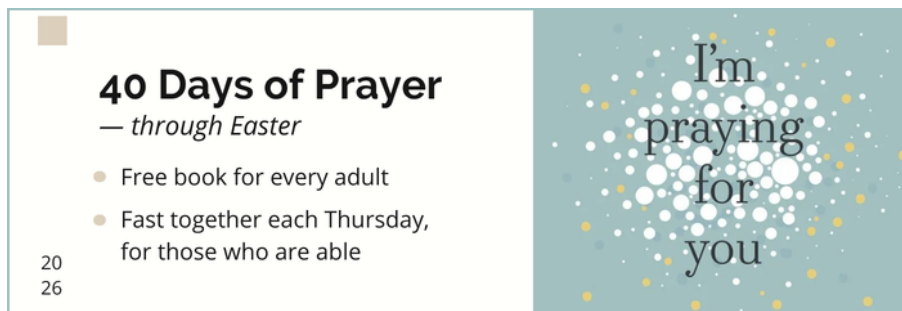
Each month we pray for another Gospel-centered church in Northern California that's seeking to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ. This month we hear from Rick Bassett of Santa Rosa Nazarene Church tells us a little about his flock and how we can pray for them.

Santa Rosa Nazarene Church is seeking to make Christlike disciples both in our local church and abroad. Locally, we're learning how to walk believers through 'hearing and doing' what Jesus has said so that we begin to take on his shape, and we're investing in some churches in Mindanao (the Philippines) so that more people might come to know and follow Christ. Besides Sunday morning worship, we focus on home groups during the week, small discipleship gatherings, a Bible study at Pauline Creek senior living center, Nomadic Shelter, and teaching at the Redwood Gospel Mission. And being a part of a worldwide denomination, we support our denomination's missions effort.

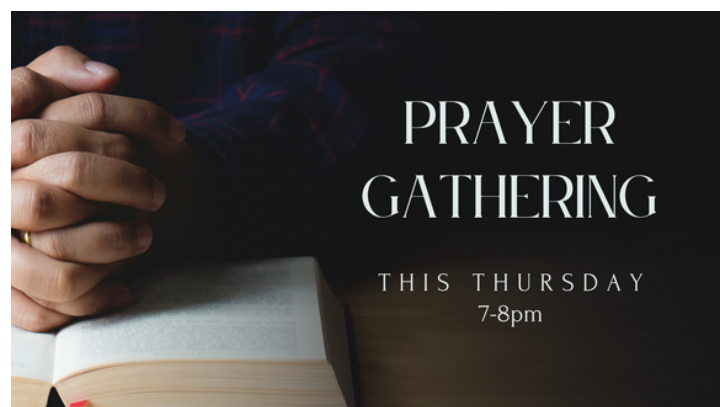
