### Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

I remember making a frightened confession of faith very young at a VBS but a more complete confession of sin and a surrender of my life when I was a freshman in high school. I had always believed God was real but hadn't truly grieved my sin and understood the cost He paid for me until that night on a youth group trip in high school.

**What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?**

I think He is teaching me to lean on the Holy Spirit more and my own plans less. He always has and always will be completely trustworthy. During this Easter season He showed me just how humiliated He was willing to be to take my sin, and how powerful He is to squash the power of death for us all!

**How did you come to be at Redemption Hill?**

My family and I were members of Calvary Community for many years before it merged with Foothills Community to create Redemption Hill.

**What advice would you give to someone who's new to Redemption Hill?**

Make yourself known and available to receive truth and friendship within the body of Christ here. Then as you get to know your wonderful brothers and sisters, be open to the Spirit calling you to minister to others here in some way. This church isn't perfect, and it won't always be easy, but it is such a joy to serve His bride with humility.


