Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

I grew up in Nevada City, California, up in the foothills — Gold Country. It's a beautiful area. There are trees, there are four seasons — snow in the winter, tonnes of flowers in the spring, it's hot in the summer, and beautiful colors of turning leaves in the fall. And we went to a really great church — Calvary Bible Church. My brother is now the pastor there!

What was your first job, and what's a lesson from it that's stuck with you?

I did a lot of babysitting jobs. The first job that I received a paycheck for was working at a company that reloaded bullet shells. I started working there, pouring the shells into a machine which filtered out bent shells, and then packaging them when they'd been refilled. When I was in college, that company started doing big gun shows and they paid me to come along and help. I learned that I did not want to work in a job like that! I was alone almost all of the time and I nearly went insane! I learned that I need people around me and team work.

Tell us about your family.

Ted and I were both in our mid-thirties when we met. The Lord had been preparing us and leading each of us to surrender ourselves more fully to Him. Ted and I met at the wedding of some mutual friends, and we hit it off immediately. By the second day, we were already talking marriage. He said, "I need to tell you that I don't have a job right now, I don't have a car, I don't have any money. All I have to offer you is Jesus Christ." Six months later we were married, and there was so much joy. We had Meghan a year later, then Hazel a year after that. Every kid changes your reality, but having Hazel was pretty huge — walking this road that we hadn't wanted. Next came Owen, and then Colt. Each child is so unique: a total challenge, a total gift, a journey of growth. Ted and I got married in San Diego, and we lived there until we moved up here at the end of 2021.

If you had a completely free day, what would be your ideal way to spend it?

Mother's Day was what my heart considers a perfect day. I was allowed to gather with my husband and kids (apart from Owen, who is in Kauai) and my brother and my sister-in-law and go to church together. The word of God was read and studied, reminding me of God's deep, sacrificial love for me, encouraging me to love others in this same way. After this rich encouragement I got to spend all afternoon playing fun lawn games, enjoying a delicious meal someone else prepared for me, and getting to have rich conversations together, interspersed with lots of laughter, allowing me the gift of understanding, a bit more, the hearts of those I love deeply. All of this lets me experience the abundant kindness and grace of God. A day doesn't get much better, except maybe those days where I get to share that abundant love with someone else.

What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?

That He loves me even when I'm not obeying well, maybe even at all. When I'm not surrendered to Him, He still loves me. His love for me is not at all based upon my doing. And that's pretty huge. "While we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." He chose us before we'd ever lived, and knew we were going to be sinning. That's crazy stuff.

- Schneiders: Healthy delivery of their baby boy; smooth transition to being a family of 4

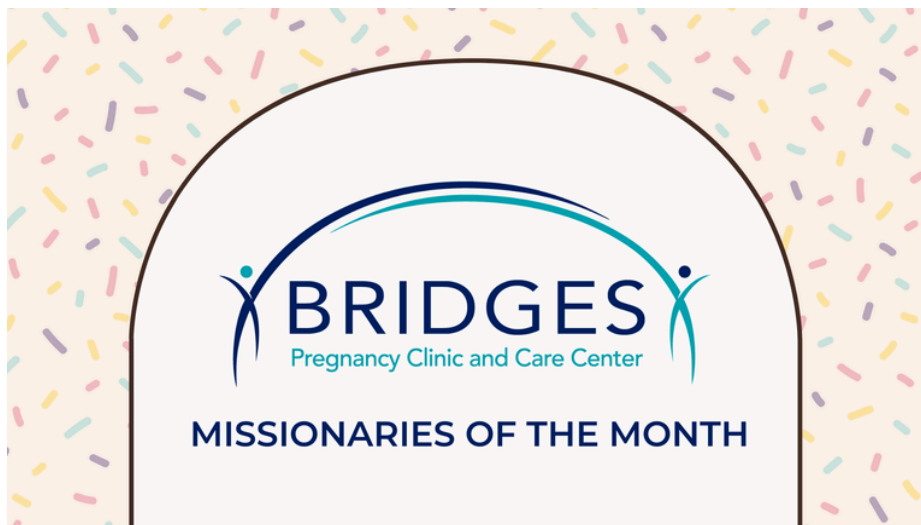

Bible Adventure Week is open to all kids aged 4-11 — especially those with no church background! Pray for and invite families you'd love to see come to salvation in Christ!

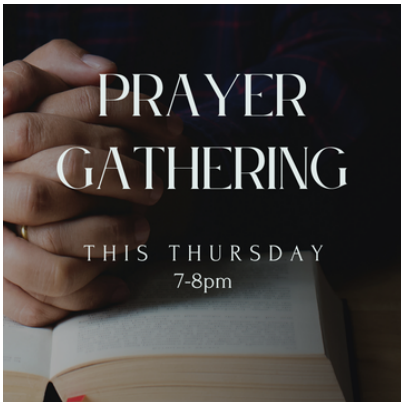
