Each month we pray for another Gospel-preaching church in Northern California. Grace Community Church, Fort Bragg is, like Redemption Hill, part of Venture Church Network. Here Pastor Greg Escher shares a little about what the Lord has been doing among and through his flock.

On Pentecost Sunday (May 24th), we set up a tent and served free hamburgers & hot dogs, live music, preached the Gospel, and shared testimonies at the beginning of the Noyo River Harbor Jetty. Six churches were represented and we dedicated the beach to God. You've heard of Pirates Cove down south — well, we're calling it Pentecost Cove in the hopes that people will step forward to be baptized.

We have baptized three in the past several weeks from a unique source. Caregivers bring our people to church as a part of their job, and they hear the Gospel and are being saved and baptized! This is the second such event; our first was a "John 3:16" festival held at our church last year which offered a

We brought in a young musician who does music for Young Life camps to be our presenter and binge watched The Chosen following the event. The City's Magic Festival was rained out and we were rained in! We will hold our next John 3:16 Festival in the Fall at the newly renovated City Park.

The 2nd biennial **NorCal Men's Summit** will take place on July 11th from 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM. This gathering is designed to be **part conference and part retreat**—a focused morning where men from churches across Northern California come together to grow stronger in their faith, leadership, and brotherhood. Our goal is simple: **to help men reconnect with God, build real relationships with other men, and return home encouraged and equipped.**

We're honored to welcome **Jeremy Stalnecker** and **Daniel Ritchie** as our keynote speakers. Both bring powerful, practical teaching that challenges men to live with courage, conviction, and purpose in every area of life.

Throughout the morning, men will also have the opportunity to participate in **breakout experiences** designed to build connection and engagement. Options will include:

- **Practical Discipleship workshops**
- A **live recording of the March or Die podcast**
- A **tactical rescue laser tag operation**—a high-energy team experience designed to build camaraderie

Men's ministry events have to have a meal involved - so lunch is included, giving men time to connect and build relationships with others from across the region.

More than anything, this summit is about something men desperately need: **brotherhood**. As you know, many men feel isolated, but when churches come together, something powerful happens. Encouragement grows, friendships form, and men leave strengthened for the responsibilities God has placed on their lives. We would love for your church to be represented. 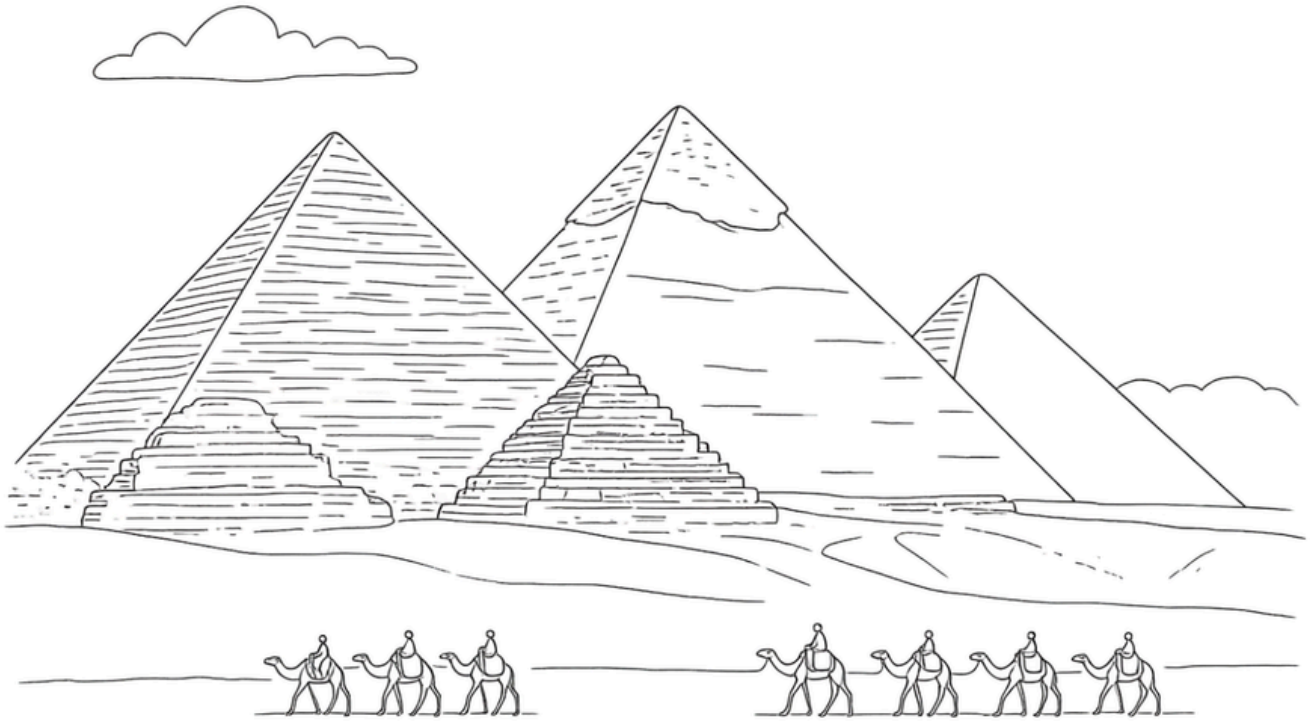

But the midwives
FEARED GOD



and did not do as
the king of Egypt
commanded them

EXODUS 1

¹These are the names of the sons of Israel who came to Egypt with Jacob, each with his household: ² Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, ³ Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin, ⁴ Dan and Naphtali, Gad and Asher. ⁵ All the descendants of Jacob were seventy persons; Joseph was already in Egypt. ⁶ Then Joseph died, and all his brothers and all that generation. ⁷ But the people of Israel were fruitful and increased greatly; they multiplied and grew exceedingly strong, so that the land was filled with them.

⁸ Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. ⁹ And he said to his people, "Behold, the people of Israel are too many and too mighty for us. ¹⁰ Come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and, if war breaks out, they join our enemies and fight against us and escape from the land." ¹¹ Therefore they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with heavy burdens. They built for Pharaoh store cities, Pithom and Raamses. ¹² But the more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied and the more they spread abroad. And the Egyptians were in dread of the people of Israel. ¹³ So they ruthlessly made the people of Israel work as slaves ¹⁴ and made their lives bitter with hard service, in mortar and brick, and in all kinds of work in the field. In all their work they ruthlessly made them work as slaves.

¹⁵ Then the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other Puah, ¹⁶ "When you serve as midwife to the Hebrew women and see them on the birthstool, if it is a son, you shall kill him, but if it is a daughter, she shall live." ¹⁷ But the midwives feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the male children live. ¹⁸ So the king of Egypt called the midwives and said to them, "Why have you done this, and let the male children live?" ¹⁹ The midwives said to Pharaoh, "Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women, for they are vigorous and give birth before the midwife comes to them." ²⁰ So God dealt well with the midwives. And the people multiplied and grew very strong. ²¹ And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families. ²² Then Pharaoh commanded all his people, "Every son that is born to the Hebrews you shall cast into the Nile, but you shall let every daughter live."
