Robin Williams recently returned from a nine-day Wheels for the World outreach trip Joni & Friends.

José is a twenty-year-old young man, from San Marcos, Guatemala. His mother was sixteen-years-old when she had him. She had to have a C-Section, and there were complications during delivery which resulted in his being born with cerebral palsy. Despite this, he is a happy young man with tons of energy. Having been wheeled in by his grandfather, Leonardo, and his nephew, Dulbie, he wanted to meet everyone he saw. His energy and smile captured the whole room and everyone's hearts!

His mom works in Guatemala City and sends money to Leonardo to help feed him. Other than that she is not really much in his life, but he is surrounded by people who love him dearly. José lives with Leonardo, Leonardo's wife, Catherine, and their three sons. He usually just stays inside all day, and when he goes outside they use a makeshift cart to get him around. He

loves to watch animals on T.V., especially goats. His aunt takes him outside and helps him cut grass, and then he feeds the local goats.

Leonardo said that José can understand when he speaks to him, and when I showed him a ball, he instantly wanted to play. We threw the ball around and even played "hockey," and he was trying to get everyone involved, which quickly took over the whole room, much to his delight!

Kari & Harvey Moriyama, from our Wheels for the World team, worked quite a long time to tailor José's new wheelchair to his exact needs, which will allow him to get out of the house more easily and to be taken to church. He was so excited to finally have a wheelchair to help him explore outside and have more enjoyment in his life. He left with a huge smile on his face as he waved goodbye to everyone in the room!

The 2nd biennial **NorCal Men's Summit** will take place on July 11th from 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM. This gathering is designed to be **part conference and part retreat**—a focused morning where men from churches across Northern California come together to grow stronger in their faith, leadership, and brotherhood. Our goal is simple: **to help men reconnect with God, build real relationships with other men, and return home encouraged and equipped.**

We're honored to welcome **Jeremy Stalnecker** and **Daniel Ritchie** as our keynote speakers. Both bring powerful, practical teaching that challenges men to live with courage, conviction, and purpose in every area of life.

Throughout the morning, men will also have the opportunity to participate in **breakout experiences** designed to build connection and engagement. Options will include:

- **Practical Discipleship workshops**
- A **live recording of the March or Die podcast**
- A **tactical rescue laser tag operation**—a high-energy team experience designed to build camaraderie

Men's ministry events have to have a meal involved - so lunch is included, giving men time to connect and build relationships with others from across the region.

More than anything, this summit is about something men desperately need: **brotherhood**. As you know, many men feel isolated, but when churches come together, something powerful happens. Encouragement grows, friendships form, and men leave strengthened for the responsibilities God has placed on their lives. We would love for your church to be represented. Consider bringing a group of men, leaders, or even your entire men's ministry.
