Youth Camp Out

Another academic year is over, and we have 11 graduates from 7 different countries (Netherlands, India, Ethiopia, Cameroon, Ghana, Pakistan, and Kenya). Graduation is our favorite time of year because it reminds us of why we are here and the ministries our students will go back to when they return home.

Even as we have graduation, we already anticipate another incoming class of 24 students starting in August. We thought last year was our biggest class in several years, but this class has more, so we're thankful that people are hearing about Tyndale and enrolling.

This term has been busy as Adam has been teaching a course on the Gospels and an independent study in counseling, along with his other responsibilities as chaplain. Anna has continued as a project manager at Tyndale, working with the president on a variety of projects, and hopes to have her current projects finished in September and will look towards new ones—as, with a school that is run by missionaries and volunteers, there are always projects that need to be done at Tyndale.

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We will be in the US this summer, staying primarily in southern California and Kentucky to visit churches and supporters and to see family, which we are looking forward to, though traveling with three kids is always a challenge.

Luke, Caleb, and Kara finished another year in Dutch school. It was Kara's first year, and she progressed really well in Dutch and now seems able to understand, speak, and sing in Dutch. She is very proud of completing her first year. Caleb's class had a unit on bugs, which led to a newfound love of looking for bugs at the park next to our house. Luke continues to read and enjoyed doing a presentation on wind power at school.

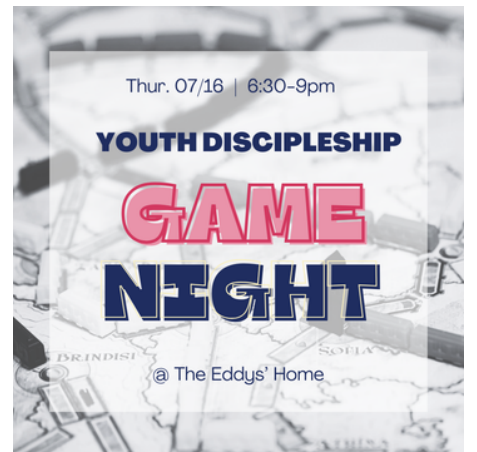

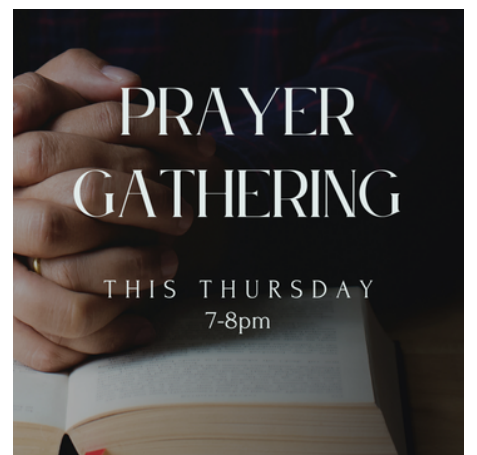

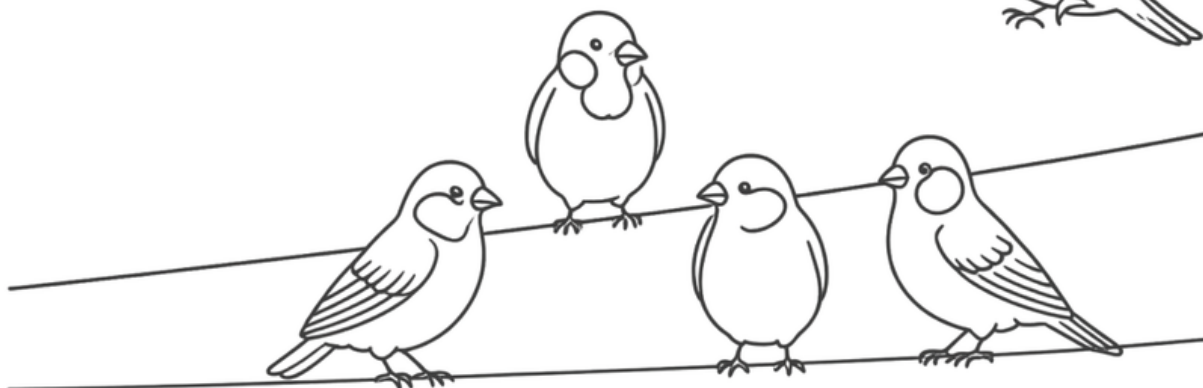
