Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

Windsor, California. The best thing about it... I love the area —it's beautiful. And I got to grow up playing sports, which is where I found most of my fun.

What was your first job, and what's a lesson from it that's stuck with you?

I worked for LandCare doing landscaping. What I learned from it is that you have to show up in good spirits. Eight hours of landscaping, especially in the summer when it's so hot outside... You've got to keep going, even when it becomes just the same thing day after day. So you've got to get your motivation somewhere else and do your best for the glory of God.

Tell us about your family.

I'm the youngest sibling of three. My older brother is Trenton; he's two years old than me, so I'm a lot closer with him because he lives in the house with me. My sister, Ashley, got married last summer and moved to Reno. I had a pretty good relationship with my siblings growing up.

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My mom's name is Alisa, and my dad is Tim (the pastor). My parents have done a great job of raising me, even in the hard seasons when they were away with all the health stuff. I was pretty young when that all started, which is what helped my relationship with my brother and sister become tight. My grandmother is Judy; she comes to Redemption Hill, and she also lives in Windsor. I have a family that I consider my second family because, growing up, I spent more time at their house than my own, and that's the WallaRces. Lance Wallace is the pastor at Windsor Christian Church. I grew up with Johnny Wallace. He's my best friend, and he's like a brother.

If you had a completely free day, what would be your ideal way to spend it?

I'd probably sleep in until 10 am, wake up and get ready, drive down to San Francisco, and go and watch a Giants game. After the game, I'd go to Pier 39, then drive back, and play some video games with some friends.

What led you to decide to follow Christ?

I grew up in the church, so it was kinda like, "This is just what we do." Then when everything started going bad with my dad's health, there were some mental bumps in the road for me. I wondered why we had to go through all of that. Then in the middle of my junior year I was playing football and got blindsided with a cheap shot to my head. It gave me a traumatic brain injury. For six months, I'd fall into depression; I missed school, and I didn't smile for months. It was the hardest time of my life — and that's saying something when, growing up, I didn't know if my dad would live. I realized that I needed to fall back on something, and that I needed to make my faith my own and lean on God and not on myself or anything around me. The world is a fleeting place. I decided to rededicate myself to God, got baptized, transferred school (which was a huge blessing), and ended up going to college. Through all of it, I've been able to see the blessing that I had blinded myself to before: that my dad is still alive, and that God has been with us through it all.

What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?

To trust in His plan for my life. I'm not going to have all of the answers about my future—although I'd like them— so I need to trust Him. And then, when God opens a door for me, I need to jump through it and not try to go my own way or find a way around it.

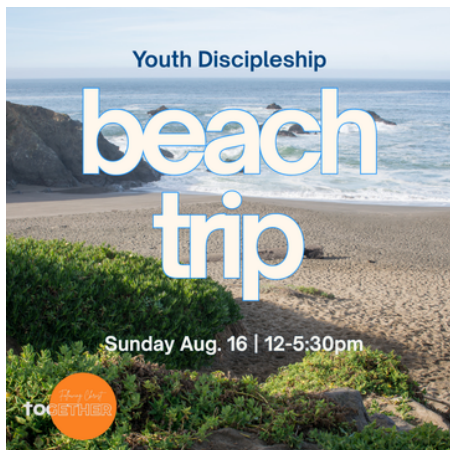
Church of the Month ❤️

Serving in Japan



Points of Prayer:

- Praise for another successful All Japan Combined concert last June 24, 2026 in Tokyo, Japan, and for the many hundreds of Japanese people in the choir and audience. There were 350 Japanese gospel choir members on stage and about 800 in the audience.
- For a reservation of a large hall in Tokyo for next year June or July 2027. We have not been able to reserve a hall for next year.
- For all the preparation for Fall 2026 Hallelujah Gospel Family resources. Textbooks, music charts, instrumentation, etc. that go to about 1,000 gospel choir members.
- New initiatives to reach the 99% of Japanese. I was able to open a new for-profit corporation here in Japan to offer services and events that will try to attract new customers who will become part of a new community and then make relationships that will introduce them to Christ and the church.
