I will be traveling to Costa Rica for the Joni and Friends' Wheels for the World Mission, October 8th through 18th. This will be my second time going to Costa Rica with our Joni and Friends team and my third Wheels for the World mission.

Wheelchairs are donated from across the country and then shipped to a US correctional facility, where inmates restore the wheelchairs to a like-new condition. These are then sent all over the world, ready to be distributed to families from local communities when the Wheels for the World outreach team arrives. In thirty years Joni and Friends has distributed over 246,000 wheelchairs to numerous countries around the world — along with the hope and love of God, proclaiming His Good News of salvation in Jesus Christ. These gifts of wheelchairs and other mobility aids also assure the beneficiary and their relatives that they are created in the image of God, are not forgotten by the Lord,

and that, through Christ, they can be part of his Body. Each recipient also receives a Bible in their own language.

I will be serving as a Support Volunteer during the Distribution Week. I am part of a three-person team, which also includes a mechanic and a seating therapist. My role is to give support, love, and prayers for each recipient and the family that comes with them. I spend time with them, get to know their story, pray with them, and sometimes provide a shoulder to cry on. Each recipient receives a hand-tailored wheelchair to meet their specific needs for mobility.

Serving with Joni and Friends is, and has been, the greatest experience of my life. I am so thankful to Jesus for the privilege and honor of "going and making disciples of all nations." By his grace, I am able to help meet the needs of people for mobility and also their need for dignity and a place of belonging. Thank you SO MUCH for your love, prayers, and support of this vital ministry and of my participation. I take each of you with me and I go and serve. You are also a part of my team!

- For safety and health during travels and the mission.



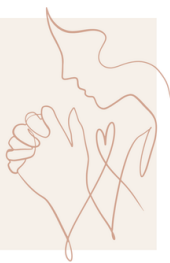
Pray:
