Thank you for the opportunity to share a little of what God is doing at Windsor Christian Church.

We are excited about several upcoming opportunities to minister to families in our church and community, including a Father-Daughter Campout, a parenting class, and our annual Trunk or Treat event.

We also praise God that last month our church members approved four new deacons (bringing our Deacon Board to fourteen) who will help serve and support the various ministries of our church. We are thankful for their willingness to serve and for the ways God continues to raise up leaders within our congregation. One of the ministries we are focused on is our ministry to widows and widowers, with a desire to provide greater connection, encouragement, and support for those in our church family who have experienced the loss of a spouse.

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This fall we will also begin a new monthly Sunday Night Service. These evenings will provide space for a variety of special gatherings throughout the year, including Praise & Prayer Nights, Q&A sessions with our elders, and special guest speakers on topics that can encourage and equip our families.

Finally, last month, we celebrated our sixty-year anniversary as a church! Back in 1966, a Sunday School group in Windsor that was meeting on Starr Rd and Old Redwood Hwy hired Jim Cook to be their pastor. Now, sixty years later, we are praising God for his faithfulness through the generations. We are thankful for all that God is doing here both through the church and through Windsor Christian Academy. We deeply appreciate the prayers of the Redemption Hill family for us as your Church of the Month. It is a blessing to serve Christ alongside other faithful churches in our community.

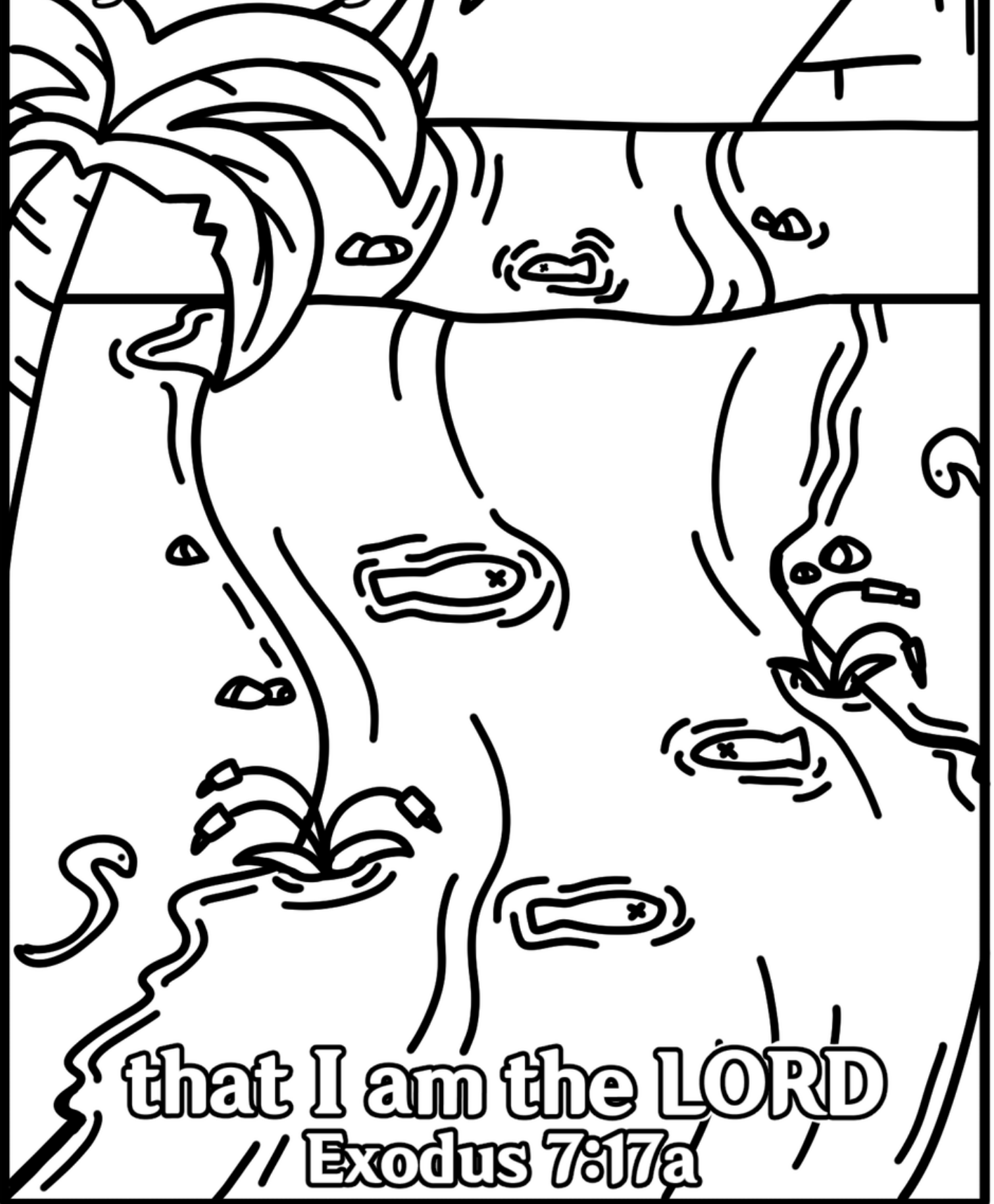
