Adam Peacocke is one of our supported missionaries. He leads FeatherVine, a ministry focused on developing unity among churches in Sonoma County, supporting them as they reach out to their local communities.

I am so thankful to the Redemption Hill community for their faithful support of FeatherVine since 2017. This has made it possible for FeatherVine to serve local congregations in being an abiding and faithful presence sharing the love of Jesus and hope of the gospel in this beautiful place God has called us. We are deeply encouraged to see God's grace at work here in Santa Rosa and Sonoma County. Here are a few recent highlights...

School Outreach – As the new school year is getting started, we remain amazed at the grace God has been bestowing on this outreach. Last month a film crew came and captured testimonies from four of these partnerships, which included both Christians and non-Christians talking about how important these partnerships have been to staff, families, and students in need. Then, on the first day of school, our churches were able to come together and provide lunch for 450 staff members for elementary schools. This outreach opened the door for two schools to express interest in having a partner relationship with a local church.

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2025

Disaster Response – Since the 2017 fires, FeatherVine has been honored to help coordinate the disaster response efforts of local churches across Sonoma County. The help churches provide have always been appreciated, but after what has taken place in recent years, both the County of Sonoma and City of Santa Rosa's government leaders have reached out to invite FeatherVine to coordinate for the churches to have a presence INSIDE their Emergency Operations Center when disaster strikes. Last month we hosted our first ever readiness event for Sonoma County congregations and leaders from across the Bay Area came to see what is happening here in Sonoma County as a potential model for churches across the region. We now have roughly 100 faith-based organizations committed to collaborate so we can maximize the practical help we can offer and position the Body of Christ to shine as salt and light during dark times.

Cultivated trust is creating many additional opportunities

- We are continuing to serve local churches in effective outreach, including helping families and youth in crisis through the Foster Care system.
- We hosted a strongly attended Active Shooter Training for dozens of local congregations alongside the Santa Rosa Police Department, who despite some public pushback have decided to lean into Faith and Blue again this October because of their value for the relationship with our congregations.
- FeatherVine has leaned into a growing hunger for expressions of united prayer by hosting twice monthly prayer walks at different locations in the city of Santa Rosa, monthly in Petaluma, and quarterly in Windsor.


Please Pray - Here are 3 specific prayer requests for FeatherVine -
