Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

I was born in Fresno CA and moved to Windsor just before my fifth birthday. We lived in the same house until I moved out in my early twenties. Living in the same spot for so many years was fantastic because we were able to build deep relationships with the families, young and old, who lived in our cul-de-sac.

What was your first job, and what's a lesson from it that's stuck with you?

I worked for the widow who lived next door. I started by raking her willow leaves, and eventually was her general gardener and handyman. What I learned from that work was both the value of working hard and the value of taking care of others. Both are satisfying in different ways; being able to provide for my own needs and wants was great, and seeing a job well done and the effect I could have was really good to learn young.

Tell us about your family.

I grew up with my mom, dad, one older brother and sister, and one younger brother. My brothers and their families are still here in town, my sister and her family are in Fresno, and my parents are in Trinity County. I live now with my wife of 6 years, Alena, and our daughter, Mavis, who will be 2 on Thanksgiving.

If you had a completely free day, what would be your ideal way to spend it?

I would go out and play a round of disc golf, spend some time with the family, and then spend the evening with a group of guys, either just catching up or playing board games.

What led you to decide to follow Christ?

I have been a follower of Christ as long as I can remember. I made my profession of faith while in my Awana Cubbies class before we moved to Windsor. I have no clear memory of this time, so for me it has always been the truth. Since then He has proven himself to me over and over again.

What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?

He is teaching me how to be a better leader of my family. To be slow to speak and quick to listen, encouraging gently with the heart of whatever is going on. To be more thoughtful in how I spend my time and resources for the betterment of my family. To be more purposeful in stopping and praying first out loud as a family, not just in my head.

How did you come to be at Redemption Hill?


I worked at the Starbucks in Windsor where Pastor Tim would sit and do sermon prep. Seeing a man regularly at the same table with a bible and a laptop, I began to talk with him and get to know him, finding out he was a pastor and that his church and another were working on a merger. This was interesting and I followed along with the progress. I immediately really liked him and felt a kinship with him and appreciated the doctrine we had talked about. When I later felt it was time to move on from the church I had been attending, I came to visit Redemption on the week after the merger and never looked back.

What advice would you give to someone who's new to Redemption Hill?

Dig in. There are so many fantastic relationships to be had here. There are so many brothers and sisters who will build you up in Christ and are so much fun to be around. Find a bible study and join it. Invest that time into your relationship with the Lord and in the family that this church is.


