CHURCH OF THE MONTH: Santa Rosa Nazarene

Each month, we pray for another local church that's seeking to proclaim the gospel of Christ in Sonoma County. This week, Rick Bassett of Santa Rosa Nazarene Church, shares a little about his flock and how we can be in prayer for them.

Santa Rosa Nazarene Church was planted in 1912 to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to Santa Rosa, with special emphasis on the power of the Holy Spirit to transform lives into Christlikeness.

So we are looking for ways to share that message. Currently, we're finding doors opening at Redwood Gospel Mission, at Brook Hill Elementary School, in worship services and small groups, and by participating in the "Hope California" Rally at Victory Outreach. We're also seeing some receptivity to the Gospel at Oakmont, where one of our members had a fruitful ministry with neighbors. Some of them are attending his Bible study and have recommitted their lives to Christ.

Our prayer, as a church, is to make God look good in Santa Rosa, Sonoma County and beyond. By glorifying God, reaching unbelievers, applying God's word, connecting with each other, and equipping believers.



We meet on Sunday mornings at 11:00am in our building at 1135 Farmers Lane (while also livestreaming our service), as well as in small groups on every day of the week except Saturday.

As our congregation has grown older, you could also pray that God will raise up workers to reach the next generation. That would be greatly appreciated!


