Redwood Gospel Mission is one of our supported mission partners. It is a gospel-oriented ministry, mobilizing the community to minister to the lost, the least, the lonely, and the broken with the love of Jesus Christ through various homeless services, recovery programs, vocational training, jail ministry, outreach events, and the thrift store.

"Redwood Gospel Missions, in the grace and power of Jesus Christ, mobilizes our community to minister to the needy, so that lives are transformed." That is our mission statement. Really, what makes RGM hum like it does is the churches and volunteers who partner with us.

And man, have you been humming! Earlier this year, through a gracious gift from visionary donors, RGM was able to acquire the former Warrack Hospital/SAY campus at 2447 Summerfield Road. We moved our women's New Life Program (NLP), as well as our administrative offices, there this past spring. The new facility has been named "The Family Campus." Eventually, this facility will be available to families with children.

The former Rose and Manna Home facility was transformed and was reopened as our emergency women's and children's shelter on October 1st. We housed twenty women on our first night.

RGM's Men's Ministry Center, at Sixth and Wilson Streets, underwent an extensive renovation to its upstairs guest dormitory earlier this fall. Bunks and bedding were replaced by teams of volunteers. The new beds with raised platforms are semi-enclosed to allow for more privacy among the guests and program candidates.

The main kitchen at the Family Campus is being renovated to serve our guests and women and family NLP participants. The dining area will be the new location for the RGM Coffee Shop and RGM Baking Company, staffed by RGM personnel and NLP vocational trainees. January 1 is the target date for opening.

RGM's Ukiah Center for Hope is growing, as churches in local and nearby communities have begun partnering with us. Center for Hope hosted another Thanksgiving Banquet for the Ukiah community on November 24th. You'll be hearing about more big things in forthcoming editions of Real Change.

We are grateful for Redemption Hill's continued partnership with us in providing chapel services each month. RGM's chapel services are staffed by providers from churches throughout Sonoma County. Through your faithful ministry, and that of other partner churches, the men and women who come within our chapel doors are presented with the gospel 365 nights of the year, as well as a nutritional meal following every service.

RGM began a Chaplaincy Training Program earlier this year, with its first class having been commissioned in May, and the second nearing their four-week internship. This program prepares volunteer men and women from partner churches for ministry with our guests and NLP program participants.

Please be praying for our guests, NLP program participants, RGM staff, and volunteers, as Christmas time for some of us is a very stressful time, both mission-wide and personally.

Pray for the men and women in our New Life Program, that they might know and feel the love and grace of Jesus Christ living in them.

Pray for the people still out on the streets — many of them "without hope and without God in the world."

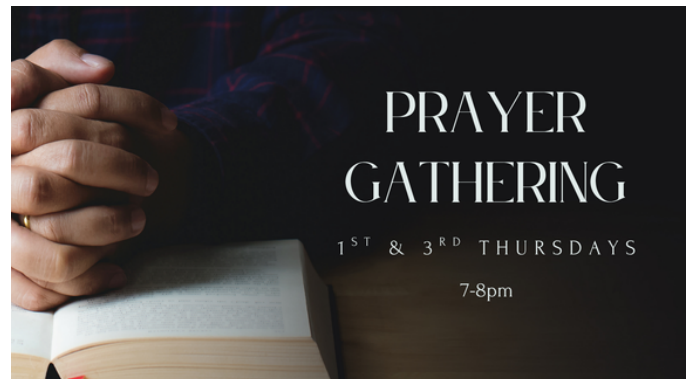


Points for Prayer:
