# Where did you grow up, and what was the best thing about it?

Here in Santa Rosa, although I was born in San Francisco. I love the beaches, the river, and the trees. We have amazing plants and animals to enjoy here. And I grew up by a creek, so I like to hang out among the plants and animals there, and Tim and I spend a lot of time at the coast. It's so beautiful.

# What was your first job, and what's a lesson from it that's stuck with you?

My first job was at Village Pastries. I was thirteen years old. It was a family-owned business and I learned a lot about the backside of the business — the baking and preparing —, and also how to deal with customers and to handle a cash register. It was a good job for a thirteen-year-old to have.

Tim and I have been married for 26 years. We met when we were in our early 20s. We have a son, Charles, who lives with us. Our daughter, Sarah Beth, has been living with Jesus since 2021. Both our kids are very creative. She's probably an artist for Jesus now. And my niece, Simone, comes to Redemption Hill too.

# If you had a completely free day, what would be your ideal way to spend it?

Normally, I would say read books. But right now my bag-of-cats-for-a-brain won't let me focus. So now I'd say, watch K-dramas! I really love the older, historical Korean dramas, Joseon Dynasty era - it's like the Jane Austen of Korean drama.

# What led you to decide to follow Christ?

I've always loved Jesus, since I was a little girl. We didn't go to church a lot, but I've always loved Jesus and was really drawn to him. Although my family didn't go to church, I would go and visit with other people. When I was in 9th grade, I was led to the Lord by my best friend's dad.

# What's one thing that Christ is teaching you at the moment?

It's beyond my daughter dying, it's beyond the cancer stuff. It's trying to listen to His leading every day and trust Him. He's teaching me to do that more than ever before in my life. Asking him, "Okay, Lord, what do we do in this moment? What's the next step?" I feel like most of my life was really living for myself, but now He's a super priority in my life. I see God in so much now. He's everything to me. I spend too much time people pleasing, trying to be something that I'm not. Now those things just aren't important to me.

# How did you come to be at Redemption Hill?


Tim and I had been looking for a new church for a while. Our old church was drifting away and we really just wanted to feed on God's Word, so we were looking for a Bible-beliving church. We go way back with the Abegglens [former long-time Redemption Hill members], and they'd started coming to what was then Foothills. The Abegglens invited us to come to their kids' baptisms, and my husband was like, "Let's check this church out." We really liked Tim Swanson. And we stayed.

# What advice would you give to someone who's new to Redemption Hill?

Find a discipleship group and get plugged in to build relationships. My group is my family. They've walked alongside me through my daughter dying and all this cancer junk. They're my support system. So, of course, spend time with Christ each day, but just going to church once a week isn't enough — get plugged in with relationships and have people to come alongside you in your life.

An AED and a Life-Vac anti-choking device are located in the Foyer. A box of other first aid supplies is in the Fireside Room, above the refrigerator.


