Celebration Church is currently looking for our next youth pastor to join our staff here in Puyallup, WA. We currently have a youth ministry that meets on Thursday nights from 6:30-8:00pm consisting of 27 middle/high school students. This group is excited, growing, and full of potential as they continue to seek a growing relationship with Jesus. The team currently has 3 adults volunteers who lead with excellence and are anxiously awaiting the opportunity to work with the Pastor God brings us to lead this ministry.

Pastor of Youth – General Responsibilities

- ❑ The seeking and reaching of people in our community who need to come to know Jesus, and be welcomed into the body of Christ whether seekers or unchurched believers [youth & adults].
- ❑ The helping of believers in becoming more like Jesus through the process of spiritual formation, building and growing our midweek youth program
- ❑ The equipping and deploying of believers for a significant ministry – developing their God given gifts, talents, experiences and resources. All staff are part of empowering of the church community in personal and corporate mission both local and global. Church staff are not hired to do the work but to equip people who do the work of ministry [Ephesians 4:11-12].

Compensation / Financial package

CHURCH AND CONGREGATION INFO

Celebration Center has been serving the greater Puyallup area for nearly 30 years. This church began in the hearts of its founding pastors Chris and Lisa Hansler who returned home to plant and fulfill the vision God placed in them. Celebration Center began with the philosophy that we would be a people that not only gathers on Sundays and grows together, but also would be a place where people can personally grow, are trained, and then are sent out to do ministry in the community and beyond.

On Feb 7th 2021, the church welcomed Pastor Dustin and Stephanie Warford as the new lead Pastors of Celebration Center. Pastor Dustin has a huge heart for unity, community, team building, outreach, and is striving to build a good relationship with the city and its schools. He is people oriented and excited to find the right person to be the Youth Pastor Position in the church,

There is a wide diversity of ages in the congregation, from families with young children to retirees, who have consistently shown their compassion and generosity. The church has a contemporary worship style, and the congregation is known for its friendliness and welcoming culture.

The church property sits near Rogers High School and Zeiger Elementary school and the church has historically worked to partner with these schools and help minister to students. There has been some successes in this area, and the multi-year, long commitment to support children at Zeiger Elementary, by providing food assistance, is a bright spot in the local outreach activity.

In keeping with the initial vision for Celebration Center, 5 churches have been planted, 3 in the greater Puyallup area, 1 in Hawaii and 1 in Spokane, Washington. The church also financially and relationally supports several other ministry organizations throughout the greater Puyallup community. These are organizations that serve in homeless transition, clothing, addiction recovery, home for pregnant teens, inner-city youth ministry, etc. Celebration Center also supports Open Bible through Mission Venture Plan giving and dedicated support to specific Open Bible missionaries serving in foreign lands. They have sent several short-term mission teams to Mexico and Argentina to minister spiritually and meet practical needs over the years.
