### Pathway Church Youth Pastor/Leader

Pathway Church is currently looking for a Youth Pastor/Leader to join our team. The church is located in Spanaway, WA. We are looking for an individual who has the desire to dream and build a youth ministry that will excite students and encourage them to build a life focused on God as well as leading others to Jesus.

We have an active youth ministry that meets regularly on Wednesday nights. This group is energetic, fun-loving and eager to learn more about Jesus. This ministry is currently lead by 1 adult volunteer who leads with excellence and love. She is anxiously awaiting the opportunity to partner with a Youth Pastor whom God brings to lead this ministry.

### Qualifications and Position Requirements:

- Called to youth ministry, loves young people, and has a passion to see adolescents
- develop a personal relationship with Christ and an excitement about their Christian faith.

- Dependable, self-motivated leader and who agrees with and supports the vision and mission of Pathway Church.

#### Duties and Responsibilities:

- (1) Facilitates the Youth Ministry program (6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades) one evening during the week.
  - Seek and invite students in our community who need to come to know Jesus, and be welcomed into the body of Christ whether seekers or unchurched believers [youth & adults].
  - Lead believers to become more like Jesus through the process of spiritual formation, building and growing our midweek youth program.
  - The equipping and deploying of believers for a significant ministry – developing their God given gifts, talents, experiences and resources. All staff are part of empowering of the church community in personal and corporate mission both local and global. Church staff are not hired to do the work but to equip people who do the work of ministry [Ephesians 4:11-12].
  - Communicate with parents/guardians and church staff on a regular basis about activities, plans, and vision with.
  - Contact students on a regular basis (e.g. personal visit, phone, email, social media etc.)
- (2) Schedule at least one activity outside of church with the students per trimester (e.g getting pizza or ice cream, bowling, golfing, concerts etc.)
- (3) Attend and chaperone students at summer camp (1 to 2 weeks. Your camp expenses will be paid to attend).
- (4) Other occasional responsibilities that are a part of the overall church's mission as discussed with lead pastor.
- (5) Be committed to personal growth in leading self so you can lead others.

#### Notes . . .

- All staff is expected to provide the Lead Pastor with a written, signed notice 30 days prior to resignation.
- All staff working with youth must submit to, and be able to pass, a background check.
