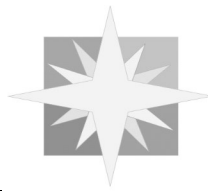

4th Annual Laying of the Crosses

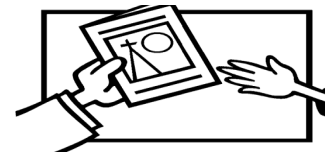
