## Mama Tola Social Program Diengenga, Congo



**What is Mama Tola Social Program?** In the remote village of Diengenga, girls who become pregnant must drop out of school and they never return. This program empowers pregnant girls ages 12-18 by providing academic classes, teaching life skills including parenting, faith development in the Lord, and learning ways to become self-sufficient.

To help this program become self-sufficient, the Congo Partnership recently financed the launch of a baking / cooking business that provides an income for their resources like Bibles, hygiene products, food, and infant clothes. To support this new business, Jonathan and Donna Baker will be taking items the project can use when they travel to Congo in January 2022. Upon their return, they will be sharing videos and stories of these women and children with Lake Deaton.

**How can you help?** Purchase any of cooking/baking item and bring it to the church during November. These photos are examples of what you can purchase or donate good “used” items. No electric items as there Diengenga does not have electricity. Plastic or stainless-steel utensils are important because metal will rust in their environment.
