From the Pastor

"All Christians are truly of the spiritual estate, and there is no difference among them except that of office."—Martin Luther

As Lutherans, we believe in this idea called the priesthood of all believers. It's not a symbolic idea reserved for theological reflection. It is a truth that shapes how we understand the Church, our calling, and our life together. This means you do not need a title to do God's work. You do not need to wear an alb or stand at the altar. Through your baptism, God sets you apart to serve others right where you are.

At baptism, God names us, claims us, and sends us. This means every Christian—whether young or old, retired or just beginning a career, in school or just graduated, lay or ordained—is entrusted with a vocation. This does not mean we all perform the same roles. Instead, it means that all of life becomes a place where God's grace is made visible. Teachers, parents, nurses, students, mechanics, engineers, neighbors, caregivers, and friends all live out their faith in distinct but equally sacred ways.

This is why your presence matters. Your prayers matter. Your voice matters. Your gifts matter. When you comfort someone in grief, encourage a struggling friend, share what's moved you to compassion, serve quietly without recognition, or speak a word of hope, you are participating in Christ's priestly work in the world.

Stewardship isn't just something we talk about in the fall, it's a year-round practice of discipleship!

Rest and Renewal

Summer invites us into different rhythms. Vacation days, backyard gatherings, time with family and friends, and moments of rest can renew both body and spirit. In Scripture, rest is not a reward for hard work rather it's a gift from God. Sabbath reminds us that we are not defined by productivity, but by our identity as beloved children of God.

Our Kindness Rock Garden makes a difference in blessing the lives of people passing by. Rocks are usually taken within a few days of being put out. If you can paint a few rocks and either place them in the garden or bring them to the church office, (where they will be treated with a protectant spray), we would be grateful. **If you would like to paint in the company of others, the congregation is invited to a Rock Painting night on Thursday, 7/9 from 6—8 PM in Luther Hall.** If you have any small, blank rocks at home that you could donate to be painted on, please bring them to the church office. Events and Items of Interest

Healing Prayer Sundays are held on the first Sunday of every month at Emanuel.

On Healing Prayer Sundays we bless our prayer shawls. If you would like to bring one to someone in need, they are available to take after worship. Personal healing prayer is offered to people who wish to receive it at the altar immediately following the postlude.



Emanuel has an AED (Automated external defibrillator) which is used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. It's a sophisticated, yet also easy-to-use, medical device that can deliver an electrical shock, or defibrillation, to help the heart reestablish an effective rhythm. **Our AED is located in the office hallway, just outside of the church office. Proceed down the ramp in the sanctuary, and the AED is on the wall directly in front of you.**

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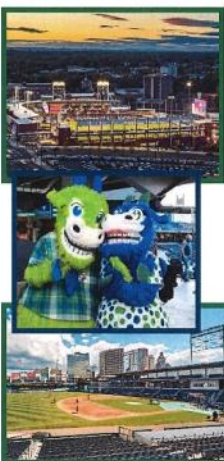
