We would take steps to avoid and look away from a person who is dressed immodestly, yet some are willing to sit through movies with such content. We would be quite upset if someone was using very mature, crude, and sexual words in front of our children, and yet many parents have turned a blind eye when such lyrics are paired with music.

We would do well to adopt David's mindset when he said, "...I will walk within my house in the integrity of my heart. I will set no worthless thing before my eyes..." (Psalm 101:2-3). Certainly not just our eyes, but our ears also. Romans 12:2, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Let's keep our spiritual security systems on high alert. It would be unsafe to allow people to access our homes, cars, and computers. It's even more dangerous to allow Satan access into our lives through the disguise of entertainment. We must not let him have his way with our soul and the souls of those close to us. In all of the entertainment we place before ourselves, let's follow the great advice of Philippians 4:8, "Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything is worthy of praise, dwell on these things."
