## Thank You, Lord!

*"Give thanks to the LORD Almighty, for the LORD is good; His love endures forever." Jeremiah 33:11*

We sing many songs thanking the LORD, and we should! There is so much to thank Him for! As Jeremiah says, we should thank God just because He is good. He is the Source of all that is good. And if that's not enough, His love lasts forever! It does not run out or run short. It does not fluctuate. We can depend on it. And we must! It is what we need the most.

Jeremiah's statement in chapter 33 is succinct, but before this in chapter 31 he highlights that God forgives our wickedness and remembers our sins no more (v. 34)! He also reminds us "who appoints the sun to shine by day, and who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night"; who "stirs up the sea so that its waves roar"! "His name is the LORD Almighty! "

God makes a new covenant that lasts forever and He takes a people unto Himself and calls them His own. (Jer. 32:38-40) He says He will "never stop doing them good". He loves us this much. It is truly awesome. Human beings can only find this kind of faithful love coming from their Maker. This is why the Beloved Apostle John says that, "God lavishes His love on us as His children". In Jesus Christ, God pours Himself out, and John says that God is love. Paul says that God is pouring out His love into our hearts directly through His Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). Then he says to the Galatians that love is the first thing the Holy Spirit produces in us (Gal. 5:22). And John assures us in his first letter that if we do not have love, we do not know God.

Make a point to pause several times today to thank the LORD for His everlasting love for you. Nothing else; just this. He has made us His people and He fills us up with His love that endures forever. What could be better than that? He does it because He is the One who is good! Thank You, Lord!
