Who Is This?

“The other guests began to say among themselves, “Who is this who even forgives sins?” *Luke 7:49*

In Luke’s account of the gospel of Christ Jesus (noted above) there can be found a variant form of the question, “Who is the Lord?” This question is asked for many reasons. Pharaoh asked this question with insolence and arrogance (*Exodus 5:2*). Saul of Tarsus asked it out of astonishment and wonder (*Acts 9:5*). In Luke 7, the Pharisees asked this question due to their ignorance of Christ’s person and office.

Men often take exception to and are offended by that which they do not understand. It is clear in Luke’s account that the Pharisees saw the forgiving of sins as a divine prerogative belonging only to God (*Isaiah 43:25; Jeremiah 31:34*). It is equally clear from the gospel accounts that the works of Jesus validated all that He taught (*John 3:2; 9:31-33; 14:10-11*). Perhaps it is easier from our retrospective viewpoint to appreciate the great truth declared by John – *John 1:14* “And the Word became flesh...”

The question asked in Luke 7:49 is an important one with serious implication. Isaiah answered this question by prophecy, *Isaiah 9:6* “For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

“Who is this?” He is all that we need and more than we could ever hope for. Even as He showed Himself to be full of love, compassion, mercy, and grace to the woman in Luke 7, so He desires to be to all – *Luke 19:10*. As He showed Himself to be the Great Physician of both the physical and the spiritual, so He is to this very day – *Matthew 11:28*. He is our Friend, Savior, Helper, Lord and much, much more. To God be the glory! Amen!
