## Don't Forget to Remember

“Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits.” *Psalm 103:1-2*

It is impossible for us to know, much less remember, every way that God has blessed us. It is possible to take God's blessings for granted, to be ungrateful and/or unmindful of the fact that our every blessing is of God's grace and mercy. Psalm 103 reminds us of that we have much for which we ought to be grateful. Our blessings include not only what God does (e.g. – vv.3-5), but also how God treats us because of what He knows (vv.13-14).

A part of our “not forgetting” transcends the idea of just being consciously aware of the fact that we are blessed by God. It includes being of a spirit of gratitude that extends into guiding our actions and our thoughts. The demonstration of our thanks and praise is to be more than perfunctory verbal declarations. God's grace and mercy is to be received and exhibited by us to others. One of the many “benefits” that we have received is forgiveness (v.3) – *Matthew 6:14-15* “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”

Truly we serve an awesome God. Remembering what God has done is the background to praising Him. God blesses us every day all week long. Should not our thanks and praise of Him be evident every day all week long? God deals with us, all of us, all the time, and all at the same time. Yet, He remains the good God that He always has been. To God be the glory! Amen!
