## Don't Let The Downs Get You Down

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."  $Philippians\ 4:13$ 

To say that "life has its ups and downs" is news to no one. Yet, the quality of one's life is ultimately a choice. One can find blessings or burdens in trials. One can find joy or sorrow in times of trouble. Is this so? The Holy Spirit moved the apostle Paul to write that indeed it is - 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 "And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong."

The abundant life that Jesus came to offer to all (*John 10:10*) is not happiness because we have no troubles or trials. Rather, it is joy although we have troubles and trials. Philippians chapter 4 contains a message that helps us understand how to live abundantly. To be sure it is not easy. However, it is equally true that the power of God working in us makes this a very real possibility.

Abundant living comes from positive programming - *Philippians 4:8* "Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things." In the Bible we are taught that there is a divine law of sowing and reaping – *Galatians 6:7-8*. In the parable of the sower, Jesus teaches us that the word of God is a seed sown in the hearts of men (*Luke 8:5ff*). As it pertains to sowing and reaping three facts are to be observed. 1) One will always reap what was sowed. 2) One will reap in proportion to what was sown. 3) One must sow before one is able to reap.

Additionally, abundant living stems from right living. Right living is a demonstration of faith in God and obedience to Him. Right living is an indispensable part of being a child of God - *James 1:22* "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." It is the will of God that we submit ourselves to Him in obedience. It is then that God can use us to His glory. To God be the glory! Amen!

Because He Lives, Ricky Cook
