Grateful Every Day

“And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!” *1 Corinthians 15:17*

Our world pauses today to remember the most significant event in human history—Resurrection Sunday (more commonly known as Easter). While it is a good thing that our world takes time to remember this event, let us not succumb to missing the importance of this event because of the pageantry that surrounds it. In *1 Corinthians 15:1-4* the apostle Paul declared that there are three primary facts that comprise the gospel (the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ Jesus). The entirety of the Christian faith and hope stand on the veracity of the gospel.

The apostle further asserted that if the gospel is not true then all hope is lost – *1 Corinthians 15:12-19*.
