Circumstances or Fact?

On the same day, when evening had come, He said to them, "Let us cross over to the other side." Now when they had left the multitude, they took Him along in the boat as He was. And other little boats were also with Him. And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. But He said to them, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?" And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, "Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!" Mark 4:35-41

Over the last few Sundays, it has been mentioned in the sermons that there are circumstances (life happening in and around us) and there is a fact—GOD IS! It is easy in the comfort and security of not being involved in a particular trial or adversity to acknowledge the fact that God Is! However, it is more challenging to keep that same energy during chaos. While we were not there in the above referenced account, it is easy to understand the angst of the disciples.

Consider the circumstances. The waves were high (v.37) and the way seemed hopeless (v.38). It is no wonder that the disciples were in a panic, the outlook was bleak. Yet is that not the result of focusing on the circumstances to the exclusion of remembering the fact? Consider that Jesus had already told them how this trip would end before it began (v.35). Jesus did not rebuke them for disturbing His sleep, but for disturbing themselves with their fears (v.40). It is easy to remember the fact when removed from the storm. May God bless us to remember and embrace the fact when we find ourselves during the storm. *Hebrews 13:5* "Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." To God be the glory! Amen!
