Is There Something More?

“I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and indeed, all *is* vanity and grasping for the wind.” *Ecclesiastes 1:14*

The search for fulfillment and satisfaction in life has exhausted many an intrepid soul. The contingent that sympathizes with the lament of Solomon (*Ecclesiastes 1:2* “Vanity of vanities,” says the Preacher; “Vanity of vanities, all *is* vanity.”) is large indeed.
