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One Day at a Time

“Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day *is* its own trouble.” *Matthew 6:34*

It has been said, “*People worry about three days: yesterday, today, and tomorrow.*” The command of Jesus cited above was not a prohibition against planning for the future. It was a warning about fretting over that which we have no control and not trusting the care of the Father (*Matthew 6:32-33*). We are better served to face the actual problems of the present than being overwhelmed by the potential problems of the future.

Much of man’s consternation stems from not acknowledging or embracing the providence of God. Life is short and fragile and ultimately all things reside within the will of Almighty God. We have no power or control over what will happen in the future – *James 4:13-17*. Wise King Solomon exhorts us not to boast about tomorrow – *Proverbs 27:1* “Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth.”

The words of Jesus declare to us that there is enough to be concerned with today that we do not need to take worry from the past or try to borrow it from the future. Our Heavenly Father is both willing and able to take care of us – *1 Peter 5:6-7* “Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, ⁷ casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.” Truly we have no reason to worry – *Philippians 4:6-7* “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” To God be the glory! Amen!
