"One Thing!"

"Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." Philippians 3:13-14

In our society of abundance, it is easy to miss the significance of the number 1. We often have many things to do in any given day. We may have numerous places to attend in any given day. It is probably so that we have multiple things that we would like to do/ accomplish in our lifetime. There is nothing inherently wrong or evil with any of these. Yet, it is here that we may find ourselves challenged by the number 1. We are not always afforded the time or opportunity to accomplish all that we desire. What if I have multiple things to do but can only choose 1? What if the case happens to be that some of my desires are mutually exclusive (e.g. – *Mat*thew 6:24)? Such a case requires the wisdom to prioritize and choose and the discipline to stay the course.

Life ultimately comes down to one thing. Solomon searched life from all considerations and came to the accurate conclusion concerning life – *Ecclesiastes 12:13-14* "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil." Yet, it is easy to become entangled with the cares and concerns of this life and not give ourselves completely to the one thing that really matters. David was aware of the danger of this pitfall and was deliberate in his living concerning it – *Psalm 27:4* "One *thing* I have desired of the LORD, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the LORD, And to inquire in His temple."

The declaration of the apostle (noted above) declares that he also was deliberate in his pursuit of the one thing that really matters. One of the many blessings that we have in Christ Jesus is that God reminds and encourages us through His word of the need to be deliberate in our living concerning His will. To God be the glory! Amen!
