

"So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart," Acts 2:46

The importance of the church fellowshipping together and building relationships with one another is stressed in the Bible through both command and example. The Hebrew writer exhorted the early Christians to do so – *Hebrews 3:13* "but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin." Both referenced passages of scripture lead us to the undeniable conclusion that "church" is not to be a Sunday only activity. Our new life in Christ is just that, a way of life. As members of the church, we are part of God's spiritual family.

An integral part of family life is spending time together, getting to know one another, and supporting and encouraging one another. Life groups are an excellent way to get to know, understand, and appreciate our family. It is no coincidence that while many did not receive the gospel in Acts 2, they were nonetheless impressed by the "family spirit" practiced and shared among the early Christians (*Acts 2:47*).
