More Than We Know

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." *Ephesians 3:20-21*

God is able... This great declaration of truth and faith is one of the linchpins of the Christian hope. Like the declaration of the apostle Paul (noted above) is that of Jude – *Jude 24-25* "Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present *you* faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, *Be* glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen." In both cases, the thought of God's surpassing ability evoked an expression of praise.

The words of the apostle Paul impart to us that God can do so much more than we know. The apostle declares that God is able to do not only what we ask in prayer "...able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think...," His power is such that His ability to perform far exceeds what we may ask. No wonder then we pray in the same spirit with which the Master prayed in Gethsemane, "not my will, but Thy will be done." Not only is God able to do above what we ask, He is also able to do above what we may think. He can do infinitely more than we are able to ask or think. No wonder then that the Christian's walk is by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).

We live in troubled times. This has been humanity's lot since the days of Adam and Eve. Yet, our focus is not on our troubles. There will be days of prosperity and days of adversity until the Lord comes again. Our focus is on the fact that God is able... To God be the glory! Amen!

Because He lives, Ricky Cook
