Thank God for God

"And you *He made alive*, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)," Ephesians 2:1-5

The apostle Paul, in his address to the Ephesian Christians, spoke of the lot of all humanity. We were all dead in sin by our own transgressions (Romans 3:23). Paul delineates this fact in Ephesians 2:1-3. Except for God's great mercy, love, and grace, verse 4 would read differently. In the absence of God's compassion for man verse 4 could read, "For this reason all are condemned." God would still be holy and just if verse 4 did read this way.

However, thank God for God. It is God who makes the difference in our salvation. We all deserve to be condemned (Romans 6:23). It is God's mercy that allows us to be spared. God's mercy desires to spare us from that which we deserve – James 2:13. Paul declares to us the reason that God is so merciful to us. His great love. A love that is so great that God was willing to give His own Son to save us - Romans 5:8. All this is a matter of God's grace. We can never earn, nor will we ever be deserving of the salvation available in Christ Jesus. Yet, God makes salvation available to us because of His love, mercy, and grace. To God be the glory! Amen.
