This Was Not on the Map

"And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me." *Acts* 20:22-23

If you have ever consulted a map for directions, then surely you can appreciate that plotting one's way on a map is easier than making the actual trip. A map will show the route from location to location, but it does not show all the things to be encountered along the way. A map does not show the location of potholes or the number of aggressive drivers one will encounter. A map cannot foretell accidents or discern the temperament of everyone to be met along the way. We all appreciate that to travel is to subject oneself to certain possible hazards. This is true with automobiles and with life.

For the children of Israel the journey to Canaan was not an easy one. Along the way they encountered detours, dead ends, and dry places. These things were not on the map. Their reaction to adversity was to whine, whimper and complain (e.g. – *Exodus 14:10-12; 15:24; 16:2-3; et al.*). Ironically, Israel failed to embrace their true problem. Their problem was never enemies with superior military strength, lack of water or food, or any other external circumstance. Israel's true problem was that they lacked faith in God. The Hebrew writer declares this to be the reason that many of them failed to make it into the Promised Land - *Hebrews 3:18-19* "And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? ¹⁹ So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief."

Israel was the church of the Old Testament. Their journey is our journey. We will encounter many things that are not on the map. To be sure, the Lord has forewarned us that the road is fraught with difficulty - John 16:33 "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." Yet, to be made aware that we will face trouble does not make the trouble any less real when it appears. The Lord does not delineate every specific trouble we will face. This is not what we need to know. What we need to know is Him. The people of God are faith travelers. We are to travel by and in faith. May God bless us as we travel to walk by faith (2 Corinthians 5:7). To God be the glory! Amen!
