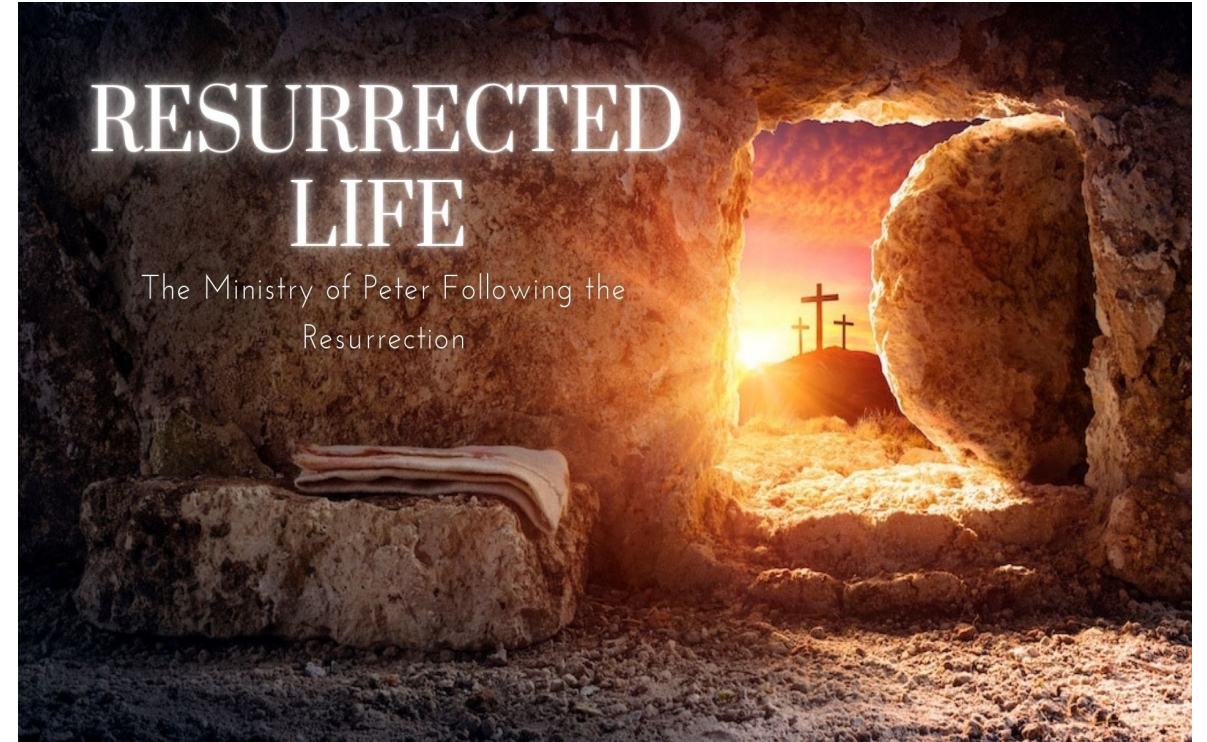

Opportunities to Serve:

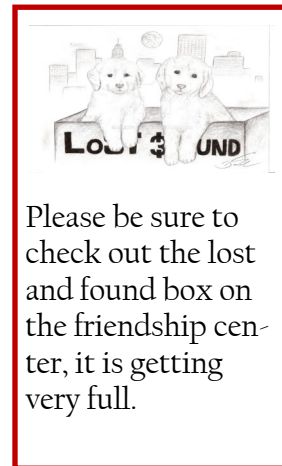
Summer Lunch
