SO YOU KNOW — AN UPDATE FROM THE ONE BOARD

As most of you know, our church has been undergoing a whole slew of changes in the last few months. With the passage of the disaffiliation vote in October, we have started to progress through a massive "To Do" list of maintenance, preparation, and decision-making. One of the things that was discussed in the last Administrative Council meeting was making an extremely conscious effort to keep all the information in front of the congregation.

Let's start from the beginning. A long while back, our Administrative Council started talking about shifting from the multiple committee style of church leadership to something the United Methodist Church refers to as "One Board." A few months ago, we decided to make the switch, and our Administrative Council became a "One Board," enveloping committees like Finance, Trustees, SPRC, etc. Due to the nature of how they work, committees like Education and Youth Commission will continue to exist because of the type of support they offer to larger ongoing ministries of the church.

Sunday, December 11th, we held the less formal vote for a new church name. The majority of the votes were for "Faith Community Church (of Sheldon)." We will continue to use the name "Sheldon United Methodist Church" until the end of June 2023 as things become official with the disaffiliation. At that point we will need to remove all items, decorations, and symbolism of the United Methodist Church from the facility. This includes things like hymnals, some pew Bibles, signage, etc.

A law firm has already been hired to make sure that all of the necessary paperwork is completed and filed properly with the courts. This particular firm deals specifically with church legality, and so they have put together a variety of things that we will need already, resulting in lower fees for us. Connected with the legal side of things is the adoption of the new church doctrine. This process will take a significant amount of time, and we will be looking at several examples of what other churches have put into place. Please cover this process in prayers as it is the most important piece of all of this changeover.

At this point, we are becoming an independent church, no part of any other denomination. At no point will a decision be made to join the Global Methodist Church or any other denomination without the involvement of the congregation. Also worth noting, the meetings of the Administrative Council are considered "open" meetings, and as such, everyone is welcome to attend. Watch for the meeting dates and times in the bulletins and newsletters, and plan to attend if you have questions, concerns, or just an interest in what's being discussed. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to the committee members.
