Administrative Board Update

As Wil mentioned in church on April 16, the Administrative Board is continuing to meet and make decisions. At our May meeting we were able to complete the By-Laws for Faith Community Church of Sheldon. After they have been edited you may request a copy to read. They maintain the basic beliefs we have held as Methodists for years. We also approved the persons to sign our disaffiliation agreement, and it has been sent to the conference office. We are completing the next steps of the move into our new name. The board also accepted a new logo design created by Dallas Bouma and Jessica Brink.

We are looking into details for the staff contracts, and moving the names of our accounts from the name Sheldon United Methodist to Faith Community Church of Sheldon.

The board has not, and does not intend to have discussion on joining with the Global Methodist Church at this time. It was promised to our congregation at the time of the disaffiliation vote that we would be Independent for a season at least. You will be informed if we decide to move into a relationship with the Global Methodists.

We also noted that in June, the members of Sheldon UMC will receive a letter from the church informing them that membership of SUMC will automatically transfer to Faith Community unless individuals request to be removed or transferred.

Our next meeting is May 10th at 7:00 p.m. All of our meetings are open to the church members who want to listen to what we are deciding.

Update on the Elevator

Last Father's Day our elevator stopped working for a short time. When we called the repairman, he came and serviced the elevator and mentioned that the control panel may need to be replaced at some point, mentioning that he was running out of parts for the current panel. He also mentioned we should update the sensory controls at the same time.

The Administrative Board approved the repairs. In April, Schumacher company came and replaced the control panel and did the updates. The total cost for the project was, \$31,155 plus tax. We are happy to report that the project fund had enough set aside to complete the project, and the elevator is working excellent.

The total of these two payments is \$167,590.00 These will be our last payments to the Iowa Conference of the United Methodist Church. They are necessary per our signed agreement to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church and have the "Trust" be placed in the Faith Community Church of Sheldon. Any extra giving you can offer toward this disaffiliation will be greatly appreciated!
