### Dear Members and Friends of the Sheldon United Methodist Church,

I am writing to inform you that we did have a special church conference on Sunday October 16, 2022. There were 256 professing members of the church (over 18) present at the church conference. The vote to disaffiliate resulted in 178 "yes" votes, 76 "no" votes and 2 abstains. The percentage of those in favor of disaffiliation was 69.5%. Those who opposed were 29.6%. And those abstaining were less than 1%.

This has been a very tense and divisive time for the congregation, and I hope that, in time, each of us can come back and worship together and continue to be the church. I encourage everyone to step up in service to the congregation. Together we will thrive in Christ! Sincerely,

### What is in a Name?

The Administrative Council, at our October 26 meeting, wanted us to extend an invitation to the worshipping congregation an opportunity to submit a possible name for our church as we move forward. The Ad Council would like the ideas to be submitted by our November 30th meeting. We will read through the proposals and dwindle them to around 3, and then ask for your help in choosing our new name. You may submit it through and email to the office, or place your idea in the box at the church. Thanks for your ideas!

### One Board

Over the next few months, as we transition from the United Methodist Church to a new name, the Administrative Council has decided to move to a "One Board" to make the decisions less complicated. Instead of nominating nine committees with nine members each, we will nominate a 13 member council who will be tasked with having listening sessions to communicate where we are headed. These persons may serve for a three year terms (the terms will be staggered so three will serve through 2023, three will serve through 2024, and three will serve through 2025). The chair of the council will be selected (we are continuing with our current chair of Ad Council through 2023) and we will leave room for a member of the women, children and youth teams. When we have our convening church conference we will be listening to ideas about committees going forward.

We will continue to have a women's ministry team, children's ministry team, and a youth ministry team headed by chair of current UMW, Michelle and Jacob. They will have a representative on the Ad Council.

Going forward, as the new by-laws are written and voted into place this "one board" may be changed to several committees again.

The Administrative Council has open meetings, and all voices are welcome to come and share.

These will be challenging times, and we request you make your voice heard and keep us all in your prayers. We will announce the members of the board as they are selected, and if you would like to be considered to be one of the members please contact pastor Kevin as in the United Methodist Church he is still the chair of nominations. We remain UMC until June as we disaffiliate.
