### **Ways to Get Involved**

<u>Communion Set Up-</u> Order the Farmers loaf with the 2 loaves in the one bag from Hyvee and make sure we have grape juice, or purchase that as well. Rosa will have the cups already in the trays. Fill them with juice and put the trays in the silver fridge. After second service dump out left over juice and wash dishes.

<u>Coffee Bar Clean Up-</u> Put any bars, cookies, or goodies away, dump remaining coffee, put left over juice in the fridge. Wash and dry dishes.

<u>Usher Duties for First & Second Service</u>— Hand out bulletins in Narthex, light the acolyte sticks, count attendance (don't forget nursery or balcony), pass the offering plates and the red sign in folders, bring offering forward during doxology, one usher should be stationed in the Narthex to greet late comers and to keep watch on the congregation in case there is a medical emergency, after first service take order of service inserts out of the bulletins and recycle them, bring offering to the office and put it in bank bag, place in it in the safe.

.<u>Faith in Action-</u> The former UMW is now called Faith in Action. We meet on the second Monday each month, and our goal is to plan activities where members of Faith Community Church can actively participate or help financially. 
