### Special Vote

I am writing to inform you that we did have a special church conference on Sunday October 16, 2022. There were 256 professing members of the church (over 18) present at the church conference. The vote to disaffiliate resulted in 178 "yes" votes, 76 "no" votes and 2 abstains. The percentage of those in favor of disaffiliation was 69.5%. Those who opposed were 29.6%. And those abstaining were less than 1%.

This has been a very tense and divisive time for the congregation, and I hope that, in time, each of us can come back and worship together and continue to be the church. I encourage everyone to step up in service to the congregation. Together we will thrive in Christ!
