In Touch

This week your child discovered that God is more powerful than anyone. The children learned that God uses his power to help his people. They learned that God is wise as well as powerful and God's power is available to us through prayer. Use these lessons to teach your child that God will love his people and protect them with his power and wisdom.

Kid Crafts

Gather O-shaped cereal, raisins, dried fruit, granola, and chocolate chips. Help your child mix a batch of trail mix. Talk about how athletes eat "power foods" such as trail mix to give them energy for their sports. Identify things such as prayer and going to church that are God's "power foods" for us.

Family Fun



Take a blanket to the park on a sunny afternoon, lie down, and look at the sky. Psalm 68:34 says God's strength is in the heavens. As you lie on your blanket, look for signs of God's power. Notice the clouds moving, the sun

shining, and the wind blowing in the trees. Thank God for showing you his power.

Bedtime Moments



Play the More-Power Game. Ask your child what creature on earth has the least power. Agree on a small animal, such as a mouse or an ant. Think of a slightly bigger animal, and then say, "I'm thinking of something

that has more power than a mouse." Let your child guess what animal you're thinking of, and then have your child think of an animal for you to guess. Keep playing until you get to people, leaders, and finally, God. Thank God for his power.

Balloon Power

Take a kite and a helium balloon to a nearby park. Tie the balloon to the kite, and watch it rise. Be sure to hold onto the kite string so you don't lose the kite and balloon. Talk about how God's power helps lift us out of tough situations. How is God's power the same as the helium balloon's power? How is God's power stronger than the helium balloon's power? As you watch the kite flying, thank God for helping you and your family stay afloat through trials.
