Ask Me...

- How can you find Jesus in your life?
- What can our family do to grow closer to Jesus?

Family Fun

- Visit a farm or petting zoo and look at the sheep and lambs. Talk about how gentle the lambs are, and point out that Jesus was called the Lamb of God. Ask your child why he or she thinks this was a good name for Jesus.
- Sheep like to follow their shepherd. Play a game of Follow the Shepherd as you'd play Follow the Leader. Take turns being the shepherd and the sheep who follow.
